KEYNOTE SPEAKER



Dr. Emilio Perucca

*Professor at the University of Pavia, Italy
Immediate Past-President and a member of the Executive and Management Committees of the International League against Epilepsy (ILAE).*

Emilio Perucca obtained a M.D. degree at the University of Pavia in 1975, a Ph.D. Diploma at the University of London in 1980 and a Specialization in Neurology at the University of Pavia in 1982. He trained as a clinical pharmacologist and as a neurologist at the National Hospital for Nervous Diseases in London, UK. He is currently Professor at the University of Pavia, Italy and Director of the Clinical Trial Center at the Mondino National Neurological Institute in Pavia.

Professor Perucca is member of the Editorial/Advisory Boards of several journals, including Lancet Neurology, Acta Neurologica Scandinavica, CNS Drugs, Epilepsy Research, Seizure, and Clinical Pharmacokinetics.

He is currently Immediate Past-President and a member of the Executive and Management Committees of the International League against Epilepsy (ILAE). He is also co-director of Epilepsy Alliance Europe (Dublin) and a member of the Board of Directors of the ROW Foundation (Chicago). He is an external advisor to the European Medicines Agency (EMA). He received the Ambassador for Epilepsy Award from ILAE and from the International Epilepsy Bureau in 1997 and the ILAE European Epileptology Award in 2018.

He co-edited or contributed to several international textbooks and authored/co-authored over 450 Pubmed-listed publications with an H-Index of 80 and a Citation Index over 22,000. His research activities have focused on the clinical pharmacology of antiepileptic drugs, the drug treatment of seizure disorders, clinical trial methodology and assessment of outcome in people with epilepsy.
