
#### Summary of Gynecology Conclave 2018

- The CME was conducted at **Chail, Himachal Pradesh, India**. It was aimed to bring together the well-known Gynecologist & obstetrician India in order to discuss various clinical aspects and challenges in the management of PCO's and its complications.
- In this CME, Different topics related to PCO'S such as
  - I. L-Methyfolate: Pregnancy and Fetal Outcome Thrombolysis : Methylfolate (Lmethylfolate) is the biologically active form of folate which, unlike folic acid, does not require enzymatic reduction by methylenetetrahydrofolate reductase (MTHFR)
  - II. New Paradigm in PCOS Management Stroke Unit : Polycystic ovary syndrome (PCOS) is currently the leading cause of menstrual complications in women. It is characterized by clinical and/or biochemical hyperandrogenism, ovulation abnormalities and the presence of enlarged and/or polycystic ovaries in ultrasound images.
  - III. Biological Control in Vaginal Infections Neurointervention in Acute Stroke : The human vaginal microbiota plays an important role in the maintenance of a woman's health, as well as of her partner's and newborns'. When this predominantly Lactobacillus community is disrupted, decreased in abundance and replaced by different anaerobes, bacterial vaginosis (BV) may occur. BV is associated with ascending infections and obstetrical complications, such as chorioamnionitis and preterm delivery, as well as with urinary tract infections and sexually transmitted infections. Workshop, Technological Breakthrough in Calcium were discussed

- IV. Polycystic ovary syndrome (PCOS) is currently the leading cause of menstrual complications in women: It is characterized by clinical and/or biochemical hyperandrogenism, ovulation abnormalities and the presence of enlarged and/or polycystic ovaries
- Different cases were explained to the audience and the whole case was open for discussion. Audience actively participated in the discussion regarding the management of PCO's and its complications. It was a very interactive session and the delegates thoroughly enjoyed it.
- Participants were keen to share their experience and knowledge and they also provided their critiques and recommendations on the event.




